This letter is in further reference to the Postal Service notice dated July 17, 2019 (enclosed), on acceptable forms of identification required for mail pickup and other services.

As previously informed, reference materials were provided to retail units to ensure retail personnel are accepting the appropriate forms of identification from customers at the time of service.

Retail Offices with Retail Systems Software (RSS) and Mobile Point of Sale (mPOS) devices will be updated effective May 22 to display a listing of the primary forms of acceptable identification for the applicable mail pickup and service transactions. The listings on the screens will assist retail clerks with expediting transactions requiring identity verification for mail pickup.

Acceptable Identification for Mail Pickup and Other Services

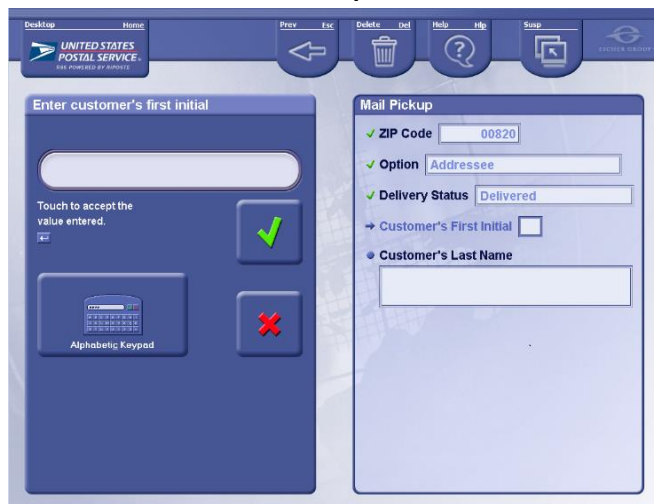
Effective May 22, 2020, Retail Systems Software (RSS) Full Window Service and RSS Mobile Point of Sales (mPOS) screens will be updated to indicate the primary forms of acceptable identification (see below) on the applicable mail pickup and service transaction screens. This change will assist the Sales and Services Associates (SSAs) / Sales, Service and Distribution Associates (SSDAs) with expediting transactions that require identity verification by providing the information directly on the RSS and mPOS screens.

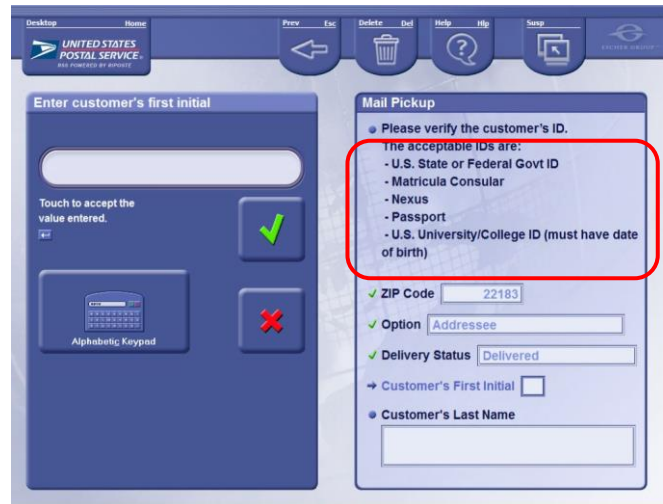

Acceptable Forms of Identification (ID) for Mail Pickup and Other Services

Q1. Why are Retail Systems Software (RSS) and Mobile Point of Sale (mPOS) work flow screens being updated to provide a list of the acceptable forms of identification for mail pickup and other services?

- A. To assist Sales and Services Associates (SSAs) / Sales, Service and Distribution Associates (SSDAs) with expediting mail pickup transactions that require identity verification by providing the acceptable ID types directly within the RSS and mPOS work flows.

Q2. Are there new Work Instructions needed with this update to RSS and mPOS?

- A. No; Forms of Identifications for Mail Pickup and Other Services were added to the existing RSS and mPOS work flow screens, therefore new Work Instructions are not needed.

Q3. Why were the acceptable forms of identification updated and added to Domestic Mail Manual (DMM) and Postal Operations Manual (POM)?

- A. To provide clarity and consistency on the standards regarding the acceptable forms of required identification required by customers for mail pickup and other services.

Q4. What ID information was updated for mail pickup and other services?

- A. Postal Service will accept certain U.S. State or Federal Government IDs, U.S. or Foreign Passports, Matricula Consular (Mexico), or NEXUS (Canada). Also, U.S. corporate or university/college photo IDs in limited cases.

Q5. Where can I find information about the acceptable forms of identification required by customers?

- A. Information can be found in the Domestic Mail Manual (DMM), 608.10.0, *Forms of Identification* and the Postal Operations Manual (POM), 131.3, *Forms of Identification*.

Q6. Are there any forms of ID that are not acceptable?

- A. Yes! In the DMM section 608.10.5, *Forms of Unacceptable Identification* it states:
The Postal Service does not accept Social Security cards, birth certificates, credit cards and other similar items as primary or secondary forms of identification.

Q7. Is there a list that identifies the identification required for specific products and services?

- A. Yes; The DMM has a chart listing the Acceptable Primary Forms of Photo Identification by Product and Service. You may also visit the following URL to view the list of acceptable IDs.

As a matter of general interest, the Postal Service is providing retail units reference materials regarding acceptable forms of identification required for mail pickup and other services.

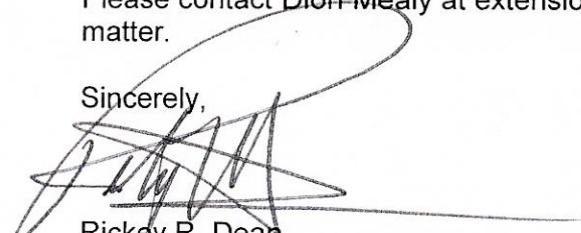
